



How to Apply for Habitat for Humanity In Floyd County

If your family has a housing need such as inadequate plumbing, poor heating, leaking roof, overcrowding (three to a bedroom), or unsafe or unsanitary conditions or you are a resident of public housing, and you have lived or worked in **Floyd County** for at least a year, and your family income is less than \$51,350, you may qualify for a house from Habitat for Humanity.

To Apply:

1. Attend one of the MANDATORY orientation meetings, May 6, 10:30AM, OR, May 8, 6PM, at the Sara Hightower Library. At the meeting the qualifications for home ownership will be thoroughly explained. If you meet these qualifications and are interested in continuing the process, you will receive an application.
2. Return your completed application to the offices of Habitat for Humanity (in the ReStore), 95 Three Rivers Drive, Rome, GA 30161, Tuesday—Saturday, 10AM—6PM.
